

Sunday Magic Carpet

Agreement between DeYi Studio and

- 1.1 "Sunday Magic Carpet" is an event organized by DeYi Studio from 10am to 1pm every second Sunday of the month.
- 1.2 Participants are invited to present something on the ground on a carpet (objects, images, gestures).
- 1.3 This is a "non-profit" cultural project. It is not necessary to present something for sale, but it's possible to sell something.
- 1.4 Participation in the "Sunday Magic Carpet" project is free of charge and Deyi Studio does not charge any commission on sales.
- 1.5 In the event of a sale, the rules of Chinese law apply to the seller (declaration, taxes, etc.), and DeYi Studio cannot be held responsible for the transactions.
- 2.1 Participation is open to chinese or foreign artists, resident in Shanghai or passing through. Amateur artists, students, childrens and neighbours can also participate.
- 2.2 Participation must be agreed one week in advance and the contract must be signed before the event begins.
- 2.3 It is possible to participate only once, or several times, with the same or different proposals.
- 2.4 The participants commit themselves to carry out the installation themselves before 10am and to be present from 10am to 1pm on the day of the event.
- 2.5 Deyi Studio can provide a carpet for the participants, but each participant can bring the carpet that suits, up to a limit of 3m².
- 3.1 DeYi Studio does not exercise any selection or curatorial functions. Proposals are the sole responsibility of the participants.
- 3.2 Participants agree to have the event documented (photos and videos) and that visuals of their installation are eventually published.
- 3.3 The participants retain all their rights to the proposals submitted and their images, but allow DeYi Studio to publish them free of charge by mentioning the credits according to the chosen license.
- 4.1 Participants undertake not to present anything that may offend the public's sensitivity (including children), or violate the law.
- 4.2 DeYi Studio reserves the right to withdraw any proposals that may be subject to criticism by market officials, authorities or the public.
